- Screen and monitor patients before and during therapy

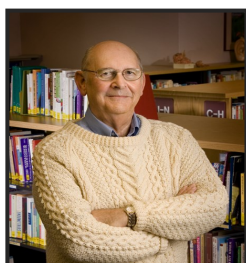

Challenging Phenotypes

- Identify psoriasiform eruptions that present in psoriasis clinic (e.g. drug-induced, concomitant allergic contact dermatitis, atopic dermatitis)
- Select and prescribe appropriate therapy, including topicals, phototherapy, traditional/new oral agents, and biologics
- Choose therapy for psoriasis in patients with underlying concomitant conditions, such as psoriatic arthritis and inflammatory bowel disease
